Athletic Trainer Secondary School Incentive Program Application

The Alabama Board of Athletic Trainers is excited to implement the Athletic Trainer Secondary School Incentive Program beginning with the 2024-2025 school year. This grant provides up to a \$7500 stipend to eligible Athletic Trainers working with rural AHSAA classified 1A, 2A, 3A, or rural Title I schools in Alabama. To be eligible for this stipend, the Athletic Trainer ("AT") must work an average of 25 hours per week during the academic school year at at least one eligible school. Should an AT cover a high school as well as a feeder school, the hours may be combined (work at an eligible high school can be combined with work at its eligible feeder middle or junior high school). Priority will be given based upon AHSAA classification beginning with 1A. The grant will be paid directly to the school district which will be responsible for distributing the funds to the AT(s) selected by the Board near the end of the 2024-2025 school year. Multiple grants may be awarded to the same school district, but only one stipend per school. If a school has more than one eligible AT, the stipend may be split; each AT will be required to submit a separate application.
